Terms and Conditions

- 1 All entries made on this form should be complete and correct at the time the entry is submitted. You should advise any changes to the Organisers, in writing, as soon as possible. This entry covers one named boat or one camping unit together with any small portable craft or day boats that persons included in your party will bring to use at the event. Refunds will not be made if you cancel your attendance.
- 2 The Inland Waterways Association Lincolnshire Branch and the Grantham Canal Partnership ('the Organisers') reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason.
- 3 You confirm that you will hold third party insurance to a minimum amount of £1,000,000 throughout the period of attendance at the event and that every camping unit and craft that you enter will be covered.
- 4 You agree to abide by all relevant by-laws and licensing requirements of British Waterways.
- 5 You agree not to leave any litter, or cause pollution to the Festival Site, the waterway, the towing path, the Gathering site or the surrounding area. This includes not discharging any toilets into the waterway and not leaving excrement on the towing path or surrounding area.
- 6 You also agree not to cause a nuisance to other people near by, whether by excessive noise or any other activity.
- 7 You must abide by the directions of any officers at the event appointed by the Organisers, and with any Health and Safety and similarly applicable regulations.
- 8 You agree not to store any article of an inflammable or explosive character (for example fireworks) on a boat or camping unit. This is for everyone's safety in the event of a fire. Fuels and lubricants stored as permitted under the Boat Safety Scheme and Gaz, butane or propane bottles used by units on the campsite are exempted from the condition.
- 9 The Organisers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage, other than that to which the Organisers are legally liable as a result of their negligence. You should ensure that you have adequate insurance to cover any accidents or losses. The Organisers will not be liable for any default due to any act of God, war, fire, flood, drought, tempest or other event beyond reasonable control of the Organisers.
- 10 Moorings, camping units site allocations are the absolute discretion of the Organisers and may be changed at any time. The Organisers reserve the right to move any boat or camping unit from the moorings or site prior to and / or during the event should the need arise.
- 11 All information provided by you will be stored in accordance with current legislation. A copy of this information can be made available to you on request to the Entries Officer, as named overleaf.
- 12 You agree not to undertake any trading whatsoever, including the advertisement of boats for sale, caravans or tents for sale, from the boats or camping unit covered by this entry. You agree not to invite any news, or other media (including television companies) to report or film without the written agreement of the Organisers.
- 13 Entry prices shown overleaf include VAT at the standard rate, which at the date of printing this form is 17.5%. The Organisers reserve the right to amend these prices as a result of any changes to VAT. The tax point is the date of receipt of this form by the Entries Officer.

2. One plaque will be made available for each completed entry form but will not be issued if the entered boat or camping unit does not attend the festival.
